## Questions and Answers:

### **DIRECTIONS:**

If eastbound on the 10 freeway, exit Mountain Ave. At the end of the off ramp, turn left and proceed north four miles on Mountain Ave to 11<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn right onto 11<sup>th</sup> Street and proceed east one mile to San Antonio Ave. Turn left onto San Antonio, and then turn right into the first driveway of the main lot. The Highlander Auditorium is the largest building that sits on the main lot.

If westbound on the 10 freeway, exit Mountain Ave. At the end of the off ramp, turn right and proceed north four miles on Mountain Ave to 11<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn right onto 11<sup>th</sup> Street and proceed east one mile to San Antonio Ave. Turn left onto San Antonio, and then turn right into the first driveway of the main lot. The Highlander Auditorium is the largest building that sits on the main lot.

If eastbound on the 210 freeway, exit Mountain Ave. At the end of the off ramp, turn left and proceed south six miles on Mountain Ave to Foothill Blvd. Turn Left onto Foothill Blvd and proceed east one mile to San Antonio Ave. Turn right onto San Antonio, and then turn left into the third driveway of the main lot. **DRESSING ROOMS:** There are two dressing rooms.

- ❖ **Dressing Room A** will have dancers from ages 2 – 8.
- ❖ **Dress Room B** will have dancers age 9 and older.

**Onstage Dressing rooms:** Two dressing rooms are located on stage right at the stage level. Each is equipped with lights, mirrors, counters, sinks, clothing racks (4 total), and a restroom. Onstage dressing rooms have video monitors of the stage and paging.

**FOOD/BEVERAGE:** NO food and NO beverage is allowed in the theatre. Water is allowed and will be sold during intermission. Dancers will be provided refreshments and light snacks backstage.

**LOST AND FOUND:** We are not responsible for any lost, stolen, or broken items. Anything left behind at the auditorium will brought back to the studio and stored in the lost and found.

**RESTROOMS:** The main general restrooms are located in the front lobby of the entrance.

**RUNNING/HORSE PLAYING:** NO running and NO horse playing in the theater, the stairs, backstage, lobby and anywhere in the theater and near the vicinity.

**SECURITY:** In order to provide the most secure environment, dancers must be checked into the backstage area (with a designated Volunteer or with an Instructor) and may **be picked up at the end of the show**. Parents are **NOT ALLOWED** (unless parent is a volunteer) backstage during the show because it is a security risk. This extra precaution can cause delays, so please be patient with us. Our primary concern is the safety of every dancer. The Highlander Theater will also provide their own staff and security personnel.

**VOLUNTEERS:** To ensure a safe, enjoyable, and successful Showcase, we need several volunteers. Loading/unloading, ushers, ticket takers, and door monitors are other examples of the volunteer assignments. The primary focus is as follows:

- ❖ **Backstage:** Volunteers needed for “backstage moms” to stay with the dancers backstage in the dressing room. Please be aware this is for the entire show. The parent(s) are responsible for the dancers once they are dropped off backstage. Assistance may also be required for dancers needing quick changes.
- ❖ **Front Lobby/Boutique:** Volunteers needed to help with the boutique in the lobby. Please be aware this is only before the show (30 min) and during intermission (15-20 min). It is not for the entire show.
- ❖ **Clean-up Crew:** Volunteers needed for approximately 30 minutes after the show to ensure everything is picked up, cleaned-up, and swept up in the auditorium.
- ❖ **Volunteer Form:** The form will be distributed soon and a meeting with all the volunteers will also be announced. If you sign up, attendance is mandatory. Please make every effort to attend the meeting, which has vital information for a successful Showcase.

**WHEN & WHERE TO DROP OFF DANCERS BEFORE THE SHOW:** All dancers must arrive at their scheduled call time and must be dropped off backstage with a designated Volunteer or Instructor. Details of the call times will be announced.

**WHEN & WHERE TO PICK UP DANCERS AFTER THE SHOW:** Dancers may only be picked up at the end of the Showcase. All dancers are participating in the finale so the Instructors will release your child onstage after the show.



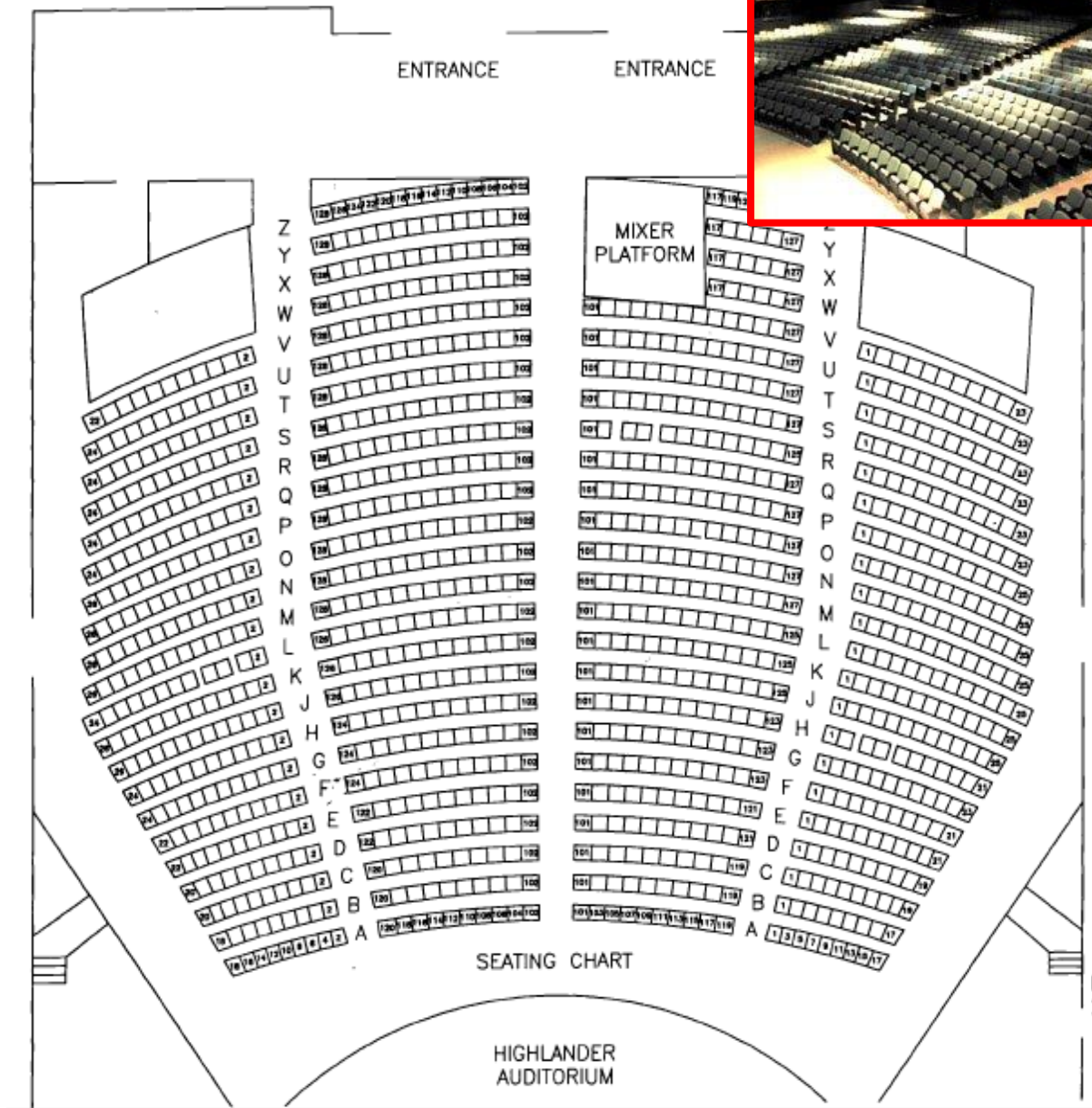

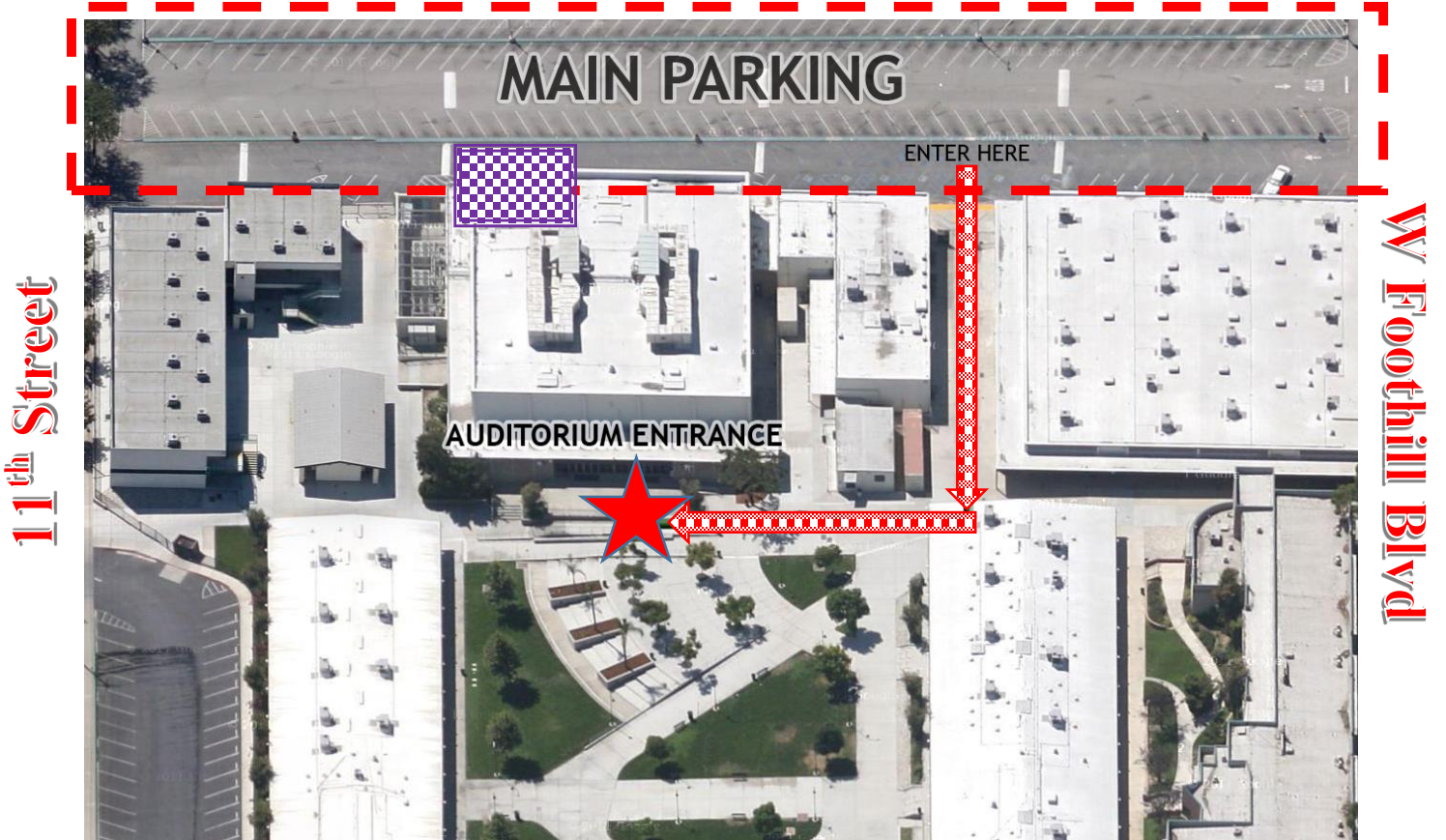

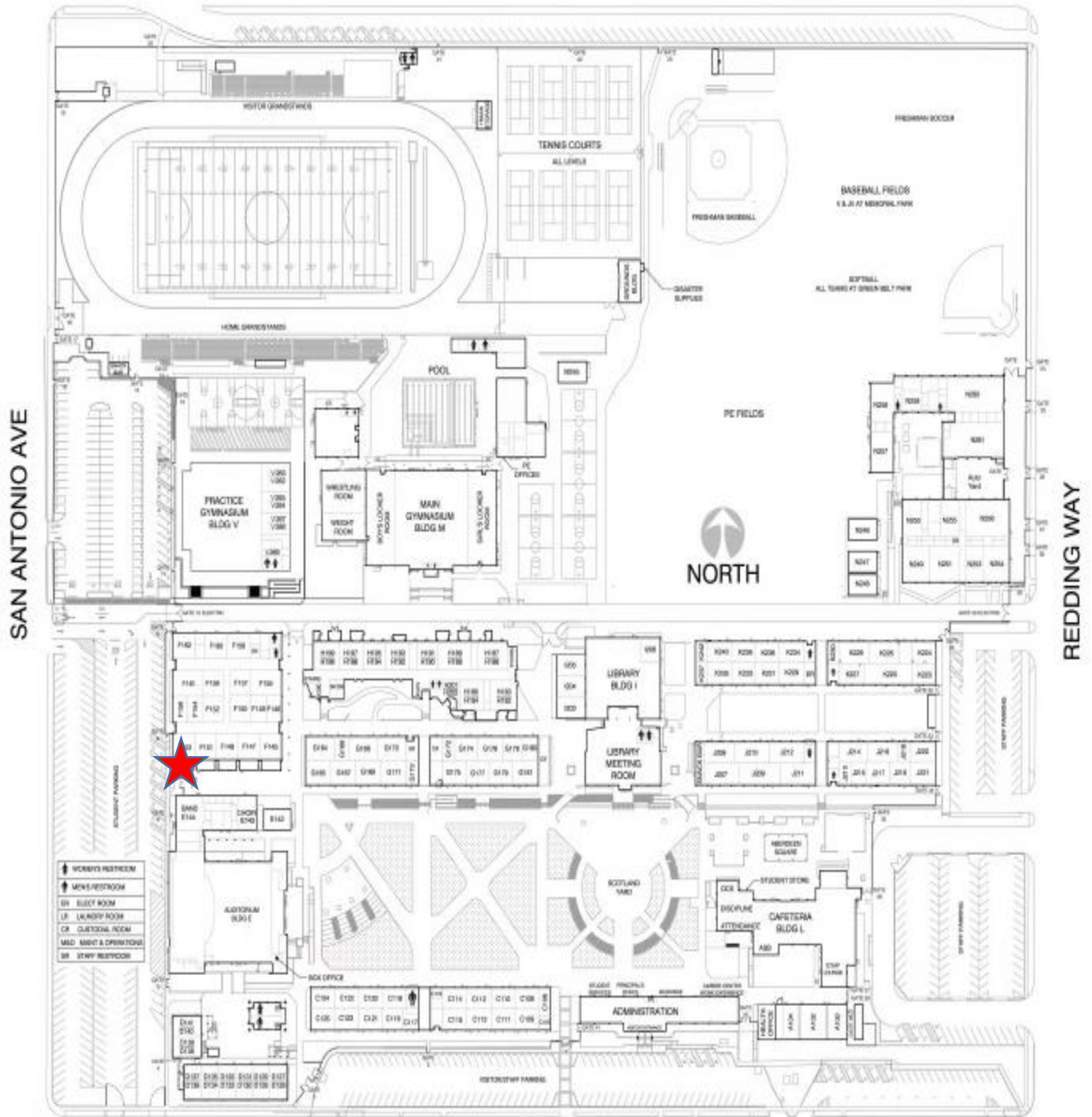

**SPECIAL NOTE:** Details of the **mandatory tech rehearsal** and run-through will be announced! All Dancers must arrive to the theater thirty (30) minutes prior to their scheduled tech rehearsal in their first costume (if they are performing in more than one routine), with make-up on and ready to run their routine(s). When dancers arrive and are not running their routine yet, they must be stretching backstage (on the side wing) to avoid injuries and ready to run their routine. Time is of the essence and we are on a timeline
